
Children should feel safe to play and learn

"Children experience violence in places they should be feeling safe to play and learn., such as homes, schools and playgrounds. In most cases it is someone the child knows and trusts. Boys are equally victims. There is a near 50% split between boys and girls presenting with abuse, violence and neglect. According to the 2016 Optimus National Prevalence Study, 1 in 3 boys and girls have experienced sexual abuse, yet only 1/3 of those would ask for help, with boys less inclined to do so. Residential Place of Care

Elonwabeni is registered as a Cluster Foster Care Scheme - we have 5 houses, each functioning as a family unit with 5-7 children in each home. Each home is headed by a House Mother.

Family Reunification

At *Elonwabeni*, we recognise that no child exists in a vacuum. We work closely with parents and family members to ensure that the child has a sense of belonging to a family or community beyond *Elonwabeni*.

3 Psychosocial Development

Elonwabeni emphasises Systemic Therapy as our pedagogical approach - which highlights 'Orders of Love', the relationship between the child and the parent, and entanglements which exist within family systems. This approach is systemic in our work with our children, and our training with staff members.

Health Centre

Our *Health Centre* supports the general well-being of our staff and children and is managed by a Registered Nurse.

The Arty HandCrafters

Young women from the surrounding communities have been producing beautiful Wire Handcrafts since 2009. Their products are exported to Germany annually.
